Dear year 12 students

Term has just ended and we hope that you are looking forward to a restful and enjoyable break during the summer holiday. You may have some questions about the arrangements for year 13, particularly because the virus is still present and we are not back to 'normal' yet. Please remember that all of our plans will be subject to change and so we will confirm details closer to the start of term.

A level results day – 13 August 2020

Those students studying **criminology, further maths, core maths** and **CeFS** will receive results. Please do not come to college; we will email your results to you at 8.00 am. It is important that you do not try to collect your results in person due to social distancing restrictions. Only year 13 students will be invited to college to collect results. If there are any progression issues arising from these results, we will contact you.

GCSE results day – 20 August 2020

Maths and English GCSE results will be emailed at 8.00 am. Please do not come to college to collect results in person.

Timetable for 2020/21

We have made plans for all students to return to college full-time from 7 September 2020. To achieve this safely in accordance with government guidance, we have had to prepare a new timetable. This new timetable will entail staggered starts and finishes for each year group. Whilst we are trying to ensure delivery of our core qualifications can happen on site, we are currently planning to deliver tutorial sessions online. PTs will conduct one-to-one meetings at college in their new office accommodation in Dr Johnson House. You will notice other changes, too. For example, year 12 and year 13 will have separate study, social/eating spaces and each year group will have their own entrance/exit to college. We will continue to implement and adhere to necessary control measures such as hand sanitizing stations and a strict cleaning regime.
