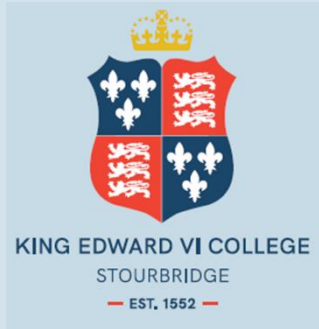


Alternatives to University Pathway



Who is this pathway aimed at?

- ❖ This pathway is designed specifically to support students who are not going to university when they leave college.
- ❖ Students in this pathway may be interested in an apprenticeship, full-time employment, a gap year, or may be unsure about their pathway once leaving college.
- ❖ The aim is to provide tailored advice, guidance and opportunities to help students make informed decisions on their next steps.
- ❖ Additionally, this pathway will focus on the skills that will assist students in employment.

This pathway will provide:

- ❖ An Introduction to the Pathway via Screencast.
- ❖ Enrolment on a bespoke MS Teams channel to keep up-to-date with job opportunities and support that is available for the chosen career sector.
- ❖ Careers Fair - Autumn (Year 12 & 13).
- ❖ Speaker Series talks/ workshops on topics including:
 - Apprenticeships
 - CVs and applications
 - Mock assessment centre & interview skills
 - Employer advisor workshop
 - Careers research talk
 - Work experience workshops
 - Industry expert talks
- ❖ Mentoring through our employer advisor and industry contacts (year 13).
- ❖ Work Experience Workshops (Mandatory) throughout year 12 & 13.
- ❖ Access to Unifrog and other careers research tools to give students essential Labour Market.
- ❖ Information (LMI) to better inform progression choices throughout year 12 & 13.
- ❖ Opportunity to attend taster days at various partner employers.
